<i>Introduction to Lesson</i>		
	<p>Review the draft pages of the publication, suggest areas to focus on for the central pages.</p> <p>Remind them of accuracy, purpose, audience.</p> <p>Talk about consistency of size of fonts, for headlines, sub-headings, text; ease of reading styles; layout of photos and rotating them.</p>	<p>Pupils explain why they have used images and text and what they want to focus on in the central pages.</p>
<i>Main part of Lesson:</i>		
	<p>Move around the pupils giving advice, suggesting resources, questioning layout, font size, accuracy.</p>	<p>Pupils continue to use the internet site, the programme, photos, scanned images and insert them in the appropriate places in the middle pages of their newsletter.</p> <p>Make alterations to their pages in the light of discussions and work done for homework.</p> <p>Print out final copy.</p>
<i>Plenary:</i>		
	<p>Give instructions about where and when to meet on People’s Day.</p>	<p>Pupils note down time and place and confirm meeting arrangements.</p>

<p>Homework opportunities: Discuss with peers, parents what might be good topics to focus on during People’s Day.</p>	<p>Pupil Support: ICT advisor to support pupils, provide comment and technical suggestions. Guidance sheets on how to use the scanner</p>	<p>Extension Activities: Re-working the images using Photoshop or other photo-editing software.</p>
